COMMENTARY ON READINGS

First Reading: The prophet foretells that God's Word will fully accomplish what His Heavenly Father has planned and will succeed in the things for which He has been sent. **(Isaish 55:10-11)**

RESPONSORIAL PSALM (Ps 65) "The seed that falls on good ground will yield a fruitful harvest."

You have visited the land and watered it; greatly have you enriched it. God's watercourses are filled; you have prepared the grain. **Res**

Thus have you prepared the land: drenching its furrows, breaking up its clods, Softening it with showers, blessing its yield. **Res**

You have crowned the year with your bounty, and your paths overflow with a rich harvest; The untilled meadows overflow with it, and rejoicing clothes the hills. **Res**

The fields are garmented with flocks and the valleys blanketed with grain. They shout and sing for joy. **Res**

FIRST COMMUNION CLASSES



SILVER JUBILEE OF REV. FR. MICHAEL AGGREY

Rev. Fr. Aggrey was born September 23rd, 1960 at Funkoe near Takoradi. He attended Star of the Sea Cathedral basic school in Takoradi.

He was an active Youth of Christ the King during the time of Rev. Frs. Amos Frerich and Martin Wels (1976 - 1994).

In 1986 he entered St. Peter's Major Seminary, Pedu in Cape Coast for his studies. He was ordained to the Holy Priesthood on the 18th of JULY, 1992. He was assigned to St. Anthony's Parish for a year then transferred to Pope John's Secondary Minor Seminary as Seminary Prefect and Teacher.

He left for further studies at Fordham University in New York from 1999 -2003 to pursue an M.A in Counseling and Spiritual Direction and M.Sc in Education.

He returned to Ghana in 2003 and was assigned to Pope John's Secondary School as Assistant Headmaster (Academics and Seminary Prefect). In 2011 he left Pope John for a sabbatical and returned to Ghana in 2015.
