

COMMENTARY ON READINGS

First Reading: Peter quotes from Psalm 16 to show God will not allow His chosen one, Jesus Christ, to experience corruption in the grave. Peter asserts further that Christ's resurrection is the very heart of the Good News. (Acts 2:14, 22-33)

RESPONSORIAL PSALM (Ps 16) "Lord, you will show us the path of life."
