THE NKONYA - ALAVANYO LAND DISPUTE IN **GHANA**

This book focuses on a 100yrs old dispute between the two ethnic communities of Nkonya & Alavanyo in the Volta Region,

The first three (3) chapters highlights on the challenges of doing research in a conflict zone, the historical dynamics of the land and the socio-economic backgrounds of the two(2) communities, Nkonya and Alavanyo.

The fourth and fifth chapters examines the migration and settlement narratives, and the politicizing of the socio-cultural differences between them.

Finally a critical examination of the reasons for the conflict and suggestions on how land disputes can be resolved is what the sixth chapter looks at.

This book is a very good resource for students reading law, land economy, history, political science, sociology, anthropology and conflict and peace studies.
