Only in God is my soul at rest; from him comes my salvation. He only is my rock and my salvation, my stronghold; I shall not be disturbed at all. Res


Only in God be at rest, my soul, for from him comes my hope. He only is my rock and my salvation, my stronghold; I shall not be disturbed. Res



1. CHOOSE CHRIST

The first requisite is the commitment to follow Christ...his way, his laws, his values. "If you love me, keep my commandments". This involves purity of thought and desire as well as action.


2. ORDER YOUR LIFE

If you should be chaste, you must make a conscious decision to avoid situations and things that excite forbidden desires...suggestive films, videos, pornographic literature, certain fashions, song lyrics etc. Thought control is crucial. Consciously replace sexually exciting thoughts with positive wholesome, non sexual thoughts. Our Lord has given authority over temptations. You can control how you respond to your emotions. As you assume responsibility for your thoughts and emotions, Jesus gives you victory over the wrongdoing. The person dedicated to purity controls actions. He or she sets a high standard of dress, speech, manners and behaviour and sticks to it.
