and we are the people he shepherds, the flock he guides. **Res**

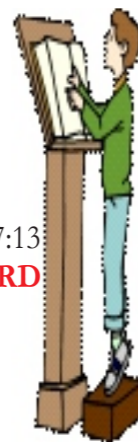
