## THE LEGAL CORNER

#### ARE YOU A CITIZEN?

A citizen of a country is a person who owes allegiance to the country and as such is entitled to certain rights and privileges.

A person becomes a citizen of a country by birth, marriage, naturalization or in line with the laws of the country.

In Ghana, a person born in Ghana or outside Ghana whose parent or grandparent is a Ghanaian at the time of birth of that person, shall be a citizen of Ghana. A child who is seven years old or less than seven, whose parents are not known, is presumed to be a Ghanaian by birth.

A man or woman who marries a Ghanaian may apply to be registered as a citizen of Ghana. A child who is 16 years or less than 16 who is adopted by a citizen of Ghana shall become a citizen of Ghana.

Taking a look at these rules, are you a citizen of Ghana?
