How could we sing a song of the LORD in a foreign land? If I forget you, Jerusalem, may my right hand be forgotten! **Res.**

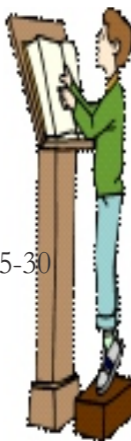
May my tongue cleave to my palate if I remember you not, If I place not Jerusalem ahead of my joy. **Res**

THE LEGAL CORNER

CAPACITY TO CONTRACT?

When entering into an agreement for sale of goods or services, you must find out whether the other person has the capacity to contract. Generally, a mentally incompetent person or a drunkard or a person under the age of 18 years cannot enter into a contract. Thus take note when a child comes to your shop to purchase goods on credit, do not think that as of right you can go and demand the money from his or her parents! The only exception where a minor can be held liable for a contract is where the contract relates to necessities or it is a contract for education, training or apprenticeship which is beneficial to the minor.
