COMMENTARY ON READINGS

First Reading: God's true servant suffers in carrying out his mission. He undergoes much humiliation for the Lord's sake but he is convinced that God will eventually justify him.(Isaiah 50:4-7)

RESPONSORIAL PSALM (Ps. 51)

"My God, my God, why have you abandoned me?."

All who see me scoff at me; they mock me with parted lips, they wag their heads: "He relied on the LORD; let him deliver him, let him rescue him, if he loves him." Res.

Indeed, many dogs surround me, a pack of evildoers closes in upon me; They have pierced my hands and my feet; I can count all my bones. Res

They divide my garments among them, and for my vesture they cast lots. But you, O LORD, be not far from me; O my help, hasten to aid me. Res

I will proclaim your name to my brethren; in the midst of the assembly I will praise you: "You who fear the LORD, praise him; all you descendants of Jacob, give glory to him; revere him, all you descendants of Israel!" Res

Second Reading: Jesus took our human condition upon Himself and accepted humiliating death on the cross for our sake. For this reason, God highly exalted Him and made Him Lord of heaven and earth.. (Philippians 2:6-11)

Gospel: Mark gives a detailed account of Jesus' false trial and suffering and he records a pagan Roman soldier's profession of faith in the crucified Christ as the Son of God. (St. Mark Chapters 14 & 15)
