

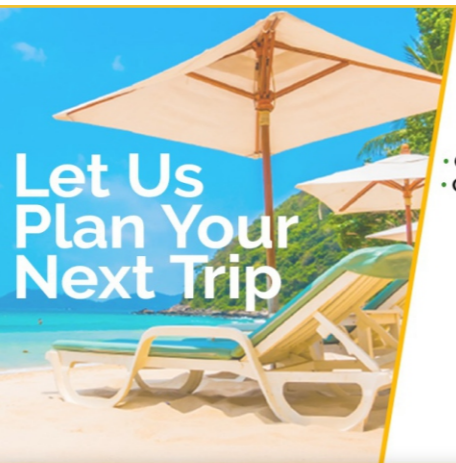

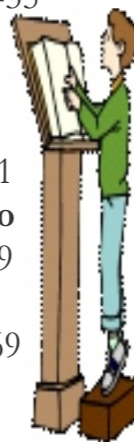

ABETMENT?
