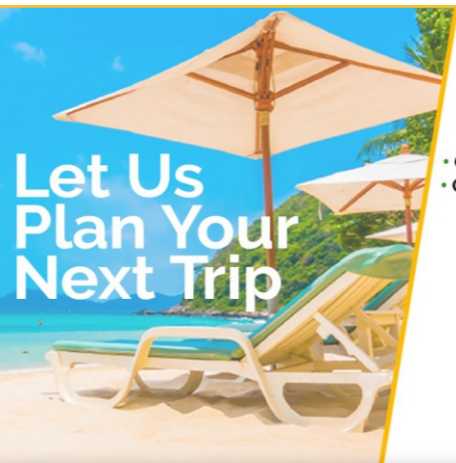

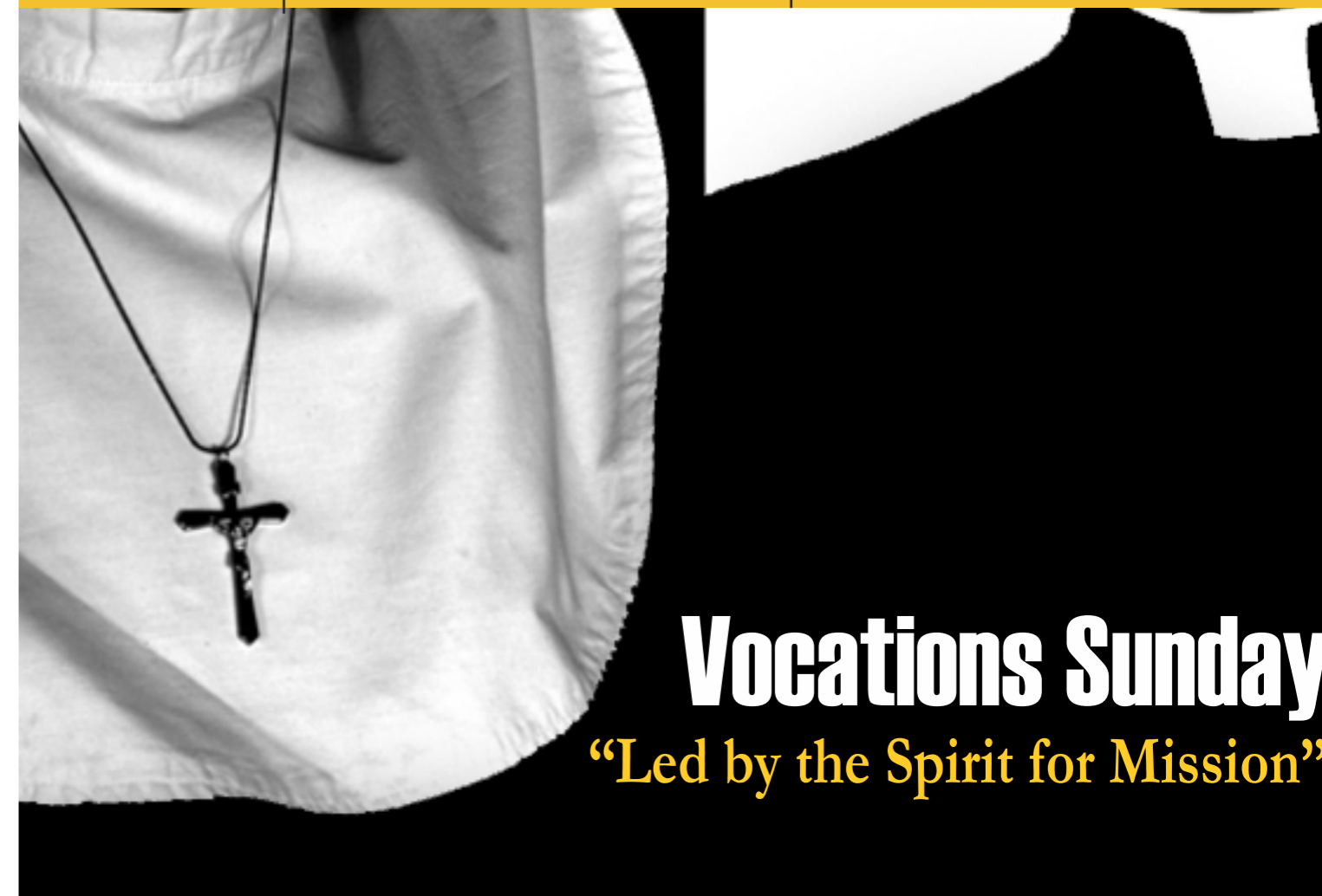

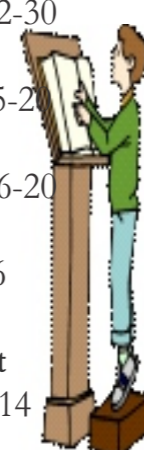

WHO OWNS THE NATURAL RESOURCES ON YOUR LAND?

Traditionally, families, stools and skins that own a parcel of land also own the gold or bauxite or diamond (minerals) found on the land. However, the 1992 Constitution states that every mineral resource in its natural state found on or in or under a land (including rivers and other water bodies) in Ghana belongs to the people of Ghana. Similar to how the Asantehene or Togbe takes care of the lands in his kingdom; the President is in charge of all mineral resources discovered in Ghana. The President is to use these resources for the benefit of the nation.
