all who go down into the dust. **Res**

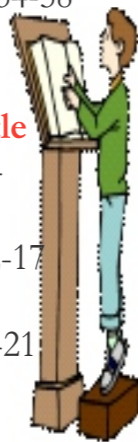
And to him my soul shall live;

KEY HIGHLIGHTS OF PPC GENERAL MEETING HELD APRIL 11, 2018

1. Nominations for Mother of the Year opens from Sunday April 8, 2018 to Monday April 30, 2018.
2. Confirmation is to be held on May 13, 2018 at Mary Mother of Good Counsel Church
3. Handing over ceremony of the Parish Youth Council takes place after 8am mass on May 6, 2018.
4. Installation of new Mother of the Year takes place on May 13, 2018 during 8am mass.
5. First Holy Communion to be held on May 20, 2018 at Christ the King Parish.
6. Parishioners willing and able to host pilgrims for the World Youth Day programme from 27th to 31st July, 2018 are to submit completed forms to the parish no later than June 30, 2018.
7. Area groups should provide names of sick and aged in their area to the Parish Office.
8. Groups/societies that have not submitted programmes for 2018 and annual reports for 2016 and 2017, are to do so as soon as possible. Groups/societies failing to do so will not be eligible for Parish support.
9. All Heads of groups and societies that have not yet visited poor and needy institutions assigned in 2017 are to do so as soon as possible. The Parish office can be contacted for support to facilitate this charitable work.
10. Parishioners are encouraged to pay their levy for the Holy Spirit Cathedral project.
11. All Heads/Presidents of groups and societies to submit names of nominees to the following committees ASAP: Social, Welfare, Laity.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

1. Must be a practicing Catholic in good standing.
2. Must be happily married or single with tangible reasons.
3. Age must be 50 years and above.
4. Must belong to at least one (1) society/group in this Parish.
5. Must have good qualities of leadership skills that could mentor the youth.
6. Must show outstanding commitment to the Catholic faith.
7. His/Her activities in the Church must be known/exemplary.

THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN STEALING AND FRAUD

Fraud and stealing are the most common offences in relation to acts of dishonesty. Stealing refers to dishonest appropriation (taking) of another person's property. Fraud, on the other hand, is where a person makes certain knowingly false statements or actions which deceive a person to part with his or her property. For instance, when you take a pen from a friend's pocket without telling him or her, it amounts to stealing. But where you lie to a friend that you can get him or her a visa to the USA and based on that he or she pays you GHC 20,000, it amounts to fraud.
