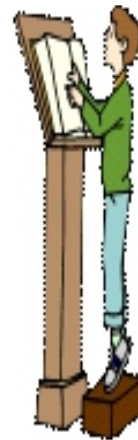

THE LEGAL CORNER

with THE SOCIAL BRIDGE

DO YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO COMPEL THE HEAD OF YOUR FAMILY TO ACCOUNT FOR PROCEEDS OF FAMILY PROPERTY? PART TWO (2)

A family member who has reason to believe that the Head of Family has misappropriated, or is about to misappropriate or likely to misappropriate common family property shall make a complaint to the other principal elders of the family. The elders of the family shall investigate the allegation to establish the truth or otherwise of the allegation.

The principal elders then shall summon a meeting of the principal elders with a clear agenda of discussing the matter and the head of family shall be in attendance. The conduct of the meeting shall be based on fairness to the parties involved and must address the matter in contention. The head of family will be compelled to file an inventory of accountability to the members of the family or account for any misappropriation
to be continued..
