let Israel wait for the LORD. **Res**

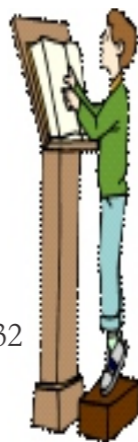
For with the LORD is kindness
