COMMENTARY ON READINGS

First Reading: The Old Covenant that God entered into with His people on Mount Sinai, was sealed with sacrificial animals' blood which Moses sprinkled over the people of Israel in order to restore the holiness of their outward lives.. (Exodus 24:3-8)

The House of St. Francis (HSF) is a residential treatment facility located in Middle East, Ashaiman and is under the directorship of Rev Fr. Eric Kabenlah, the resident Parish Priest at the Blessed Clementina Catholic church. It is a collaborative effort between Recovery Africa, Hopeful Way Foundation and the Catholic Archdiocese of Accra. The facility opened its doors on August 1, 2012 as a social model, residential treatment facility for men. It is run using 12 step and Therapeutic Community methods by staff who are themselves in recovery

The House of St. Francis has open doors to all persons suffering from the disease of addiction and drug abuse.

with THE SOCIAL BRIDGE **ADVERSE POSSESSION**

It is common to find hawkers and settlers on land that does not belong to them. A person who lives on a land that he or she does not own and does not have the permission of the owner is known as a squatter. The law is that if a squatter stays on a land for 12 years or more and the owner does not claim ownership of the land, the squatter becomes the owner of the land. This is known as adverse possession.
