

THE LEGAL CORNER

with THE SOCIAL BRIDGE ARREST WITHOUT A WARRANT

The Police must usually have a warrant (court permission) in order to arrest vou.

However, a Police Officer may arrest you without a warrant if the Police Officer suspects on reasonable grounds that;

- a. You have committed an offence
- **b.** You are about to commit an offence, in order to prevent the commission of the offence
- c. You are about to commit an offence, where the police officer finds that person in any highway, yard, building or other place during the night
- **d.** A warrant of arrest has been issued by a court for your arrest To be continued....
