with THE SOCIAL BRIDGE ARREST WITHOUT A WARRANT

continuing from last week

The Police must usually have a warrant (court permission) in order to arrest you.

However, a Police Officer may arrest you without a warrant if the Police Officer suspects on reasonable grounds that;

- d. A warrant of arrest has been issued by a court for your arrest.
- e. You are a deserter from the Armed forces; or
- **f.** You have been involved in an act committed outside Ghana which, if committed in Ghana, would have been punishable as an offence and for which that person is by law, liable to be arrested and detained in Ghana.


