COMMENTARY ON READINGS

THE LEGAL CORNER

with THE SOCIAL BRIDGE **ARREST WITHOUT A WARRANT (2)**

Continuing from last week....

The Police must usually have a warrant (court permission) in order to arrest you. However, arrest can be without a warrant. Here are some (not all) of the circumstances under which the police can arrest without a warrant;

c. Where a person has escaped or attempts to escape from lawful custody;

d. Where a person possesses an implement adapted or intended for use to unlawfully enter a building and does not give a reasonable excuse for the possession of the implement; or e. Where a person possesses a thing which may reasonably be suspected to be stolen.
