CONFESSION STATEMENT

When a person is arrested for a crime, the police take a statement. The statement may be in the form of a confession. However, a confession statement must be made voluntarily in the presence of an independent witness who certifies that the accused fully understood the contents of the statement. Next time when your relative is forced to give a statement, indicate to the police authority or the judge that the statement was not made voluntarily and as such is not valid.
