THE LEGAL CORNER

with THE SOCIAL BRIDGE **CO-OWNERSHIP OF LAND**

Where two or more people become owners of the same land, it is referred to as Co-ownership of land. Here, all the co-owners are entitled to possession of the land. There are two types of co-ownership; Joint Tenancy and Tenancy in Common.

The difference between these two types is that in Joint tenancy, if one joint tenant dies, his or her share in the land passes to the surviving joint tenants/co-owners until there's only one tenant left who becomes the sole owner of the entire property. However, in Tenancy in Common, when a tenant dies his or her share in the property goes to those who inherit his or her property. And the person who inherits the deceased person's share becomes a co-owner with the other tenants in common.
