# THE LEGAL CORNER

#### with THE SOCIAL BRIDGE CUSTOMARY ARBITRATION

Before the colonial times, our forefathers had their own way of settling disputes. The chief or an elder in the community summoned the disputants after a complaint was made by one of them.

Both parties were then allowed to present their side of the argument and the chief or elder would make a decision on the matter. This system still exists and is known as customary arbitration.

According to the law, there are five conditions under which a valid customary arbitration can take place:

**a**)The parties must voluntarily submit the dispute to the decision maker for settlement.
