# **COMMENTARY ON READINGS**

**First Reading:** Moses urged the people of Israel to keep the integrity of God's Laws and be careful not to add to, or subtract from them. **(Deut 4:1-2, 6-8)** 

RESPONSORIAL PSALM (Ps. 15) "The one who does justice will live in the presence of the Lord."

Whoever walks blamelessly and does justice; who thinks the truth in his heart and slanders not with his tongue. **Res.** 

Who harms not his fellow man, nor takes up a reproach against his neighbor; by whom the reprobate is despised, while he honors those who fear the LORD. **Res.**

Second Reading: We must do what God's word tells us to do but not just pretend to listen to it and deceive ourselves. (James 1:17-18, 21-22, 27)

# THE LEGAL CORNER

#### with THE SOCIAL BRIDGE

#### **CUSTOMARY ARBITRATION**

#### .continuing from last week

According to the law, there are five conditions under which a valid customary arbitration can take place :

- a) The parties must voluntarily submit the dispute to the decision maker for settlement.
- b) There must be a prior agreement between the parties involved to accept the final decision.
- c) The decision must be publicized.
- d) The decision must be arrived at by hearing both sides and must not be biased.

Thus, in present times you can submit a dispute to customary arbitration and the decision carries the weight of a decision made by the court and a party can apply to the court to enforce the decision of the customary arbitration.
