First Reading: The release of Israel from bondage and their return from exile, is a joyous manifestation of God's mercy and His redemptive presence for everyone without distinction. (Isaiah 35:4-7)

CUSTOMARY ARBITRATION

.continuing from last week

According to the law, there are five conditions under which a valid customary arbitration can take place:

- a) The decision must be publicized.
- b) The decision must be arrived at by hearing both sides and must not be biased.

Thus, in present times you can submit a dispute to customary arbitration and the decision carries the weight of a decision made by the court and a party can apply to the court to enforce the decision of the customary arbitration
