The LORD gives sight to the blind; the LORD raises up those who were bowed down. The LORD loves the just; the LORD protects strangers. **Res.**

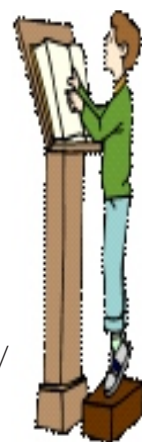

with THE SOCIAL BRIDGE

CUSTOMARY ARBITRATION
.continuing from last week
According to the law, there are five conditions under which a valid customary arbitration can take place :

- The decision must be publicized.
- The decision must be arrived at by hearing both sides and must not be biased.

Thus, in present times you can submit a dispute to customary arbitration and the decision carries the weight of a decision made by the court and a party can apply to the court to enforce the decision of the customary arbitration
