**First Reading:** God's Servant suffers greatly, although he is innocent, but he is sustained in all his trials by his steadfast faith that God will finally justify him. (Isaiah 50:5-9)

Gracious is the LORD and just; yes, our God is merciful. The LORD keeps the little ones; I was brought low, and He saved me. **Res.**

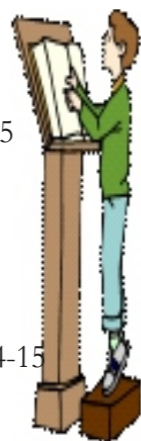
For He has freed my soul from death, my eyes from tears, my feet from stumbling. I shall walk before the Lord in the land of the living. **Res.**

**THE LEGAL CORNER**

with **THE SOCIAL BRIDGE**

**Intention to create legal relations**

Generally, it is presumed by law that agreements made between a parent and a child within the domestic setting are not intended to create legal obligations. Thus a mother who promises to buy her daughter a car cannot be sued in court if she fails to provide the car. However there are exceptions to this rule, where a father asks his working daughter for instance, that she should give up her rented apartment and move into his house to live with him on condition that she pays all the utility bills and general maintenance bills and promises to give the house to her upon his death, such an arrangement shall be legally binding.
