KEEP CALM WHEN ARRESTED

It further means that, the Police shall not unduly confine or restrain the person who has submitted to his authority. However, where the person shows signs of resistance, either orally or by conduct, the Police shall restrain the person reasonably. Thus, when arrested by the Police, do not put up a fight. It is better to go with the Police Officer without any violent resistance. Then you ask to be given the chance to contact your lawyer or request for a lawyer from the Legal Aid Office, if you cannot afford the services of a
