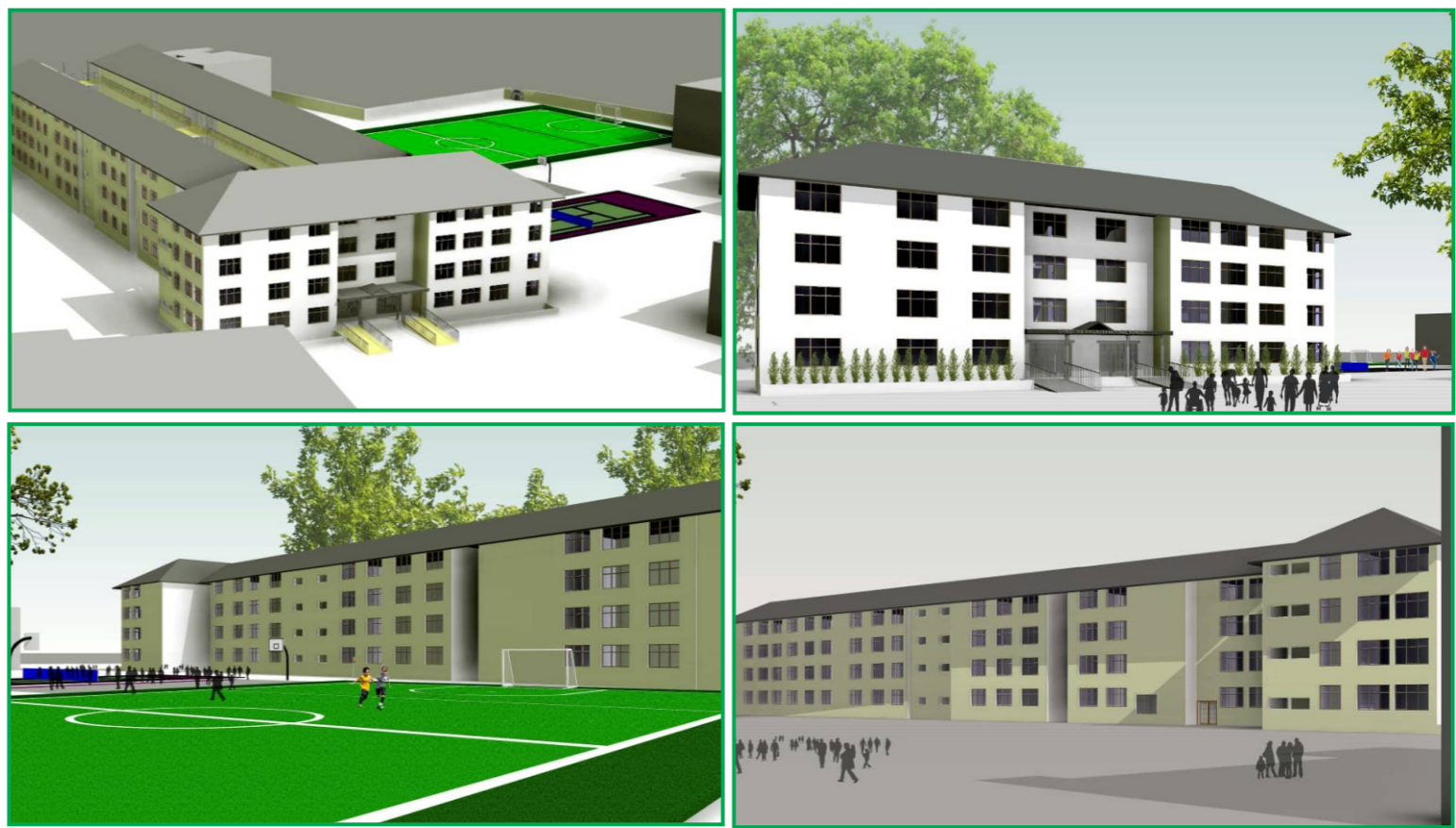

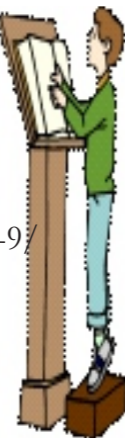

LAWYER-CLIENT PRIVILEGE

A lawyer plays the role of a spokesperson, counselor and confidant. He or she is in a position of trust. When you consult a lawyer for advice or to conduct your case, any information you tell the lawyer is protected by privilege. The lawyer cannot share the information you give him or her without your permission. The lawyer has a duty to protect your information and treat the information as confidential. However a lawyer has a duty to disclose information about criminal activities.

Always remember that the lawyer's duty is to act in your best interest.
