It is always advisable to make a will. However, when an individual dies without a will, a document known as Letters of Administration will first have to be obtained from the court before his or her properties will be shared amongst

A hierarchy of importance is usually followed in determining who is to be granted the Letters of Administration. The individuals are listed below in the order of importance the court attaches to them;

- Any surviving husband or wife
- b) Any surviving children
- Any surviving parents
- The customary successor of the deceased

Thus when a family member or friend dies, it is advisable that the abovementioned persons apply for Letters of Administration and not persons who do not belong to any of these categories.
