2ND SUNDAY OF LENT, YEAR C **COMMENTARY ON READINGS**

First Reading: The sacred writer is teaching us to follow Abraham's example of faith and conversation with God and by so doing we will experience that "the Lord is our light and our salvation. (Genesis 15:5-12, 17-18)

RESPONSORIAL PSALM (Ps. 27) "The Lord is my light and my salvation.."

The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom should I fear? The LORD is my life's refuge; of whom should I be afraid? Res.

Hear, O LORD, the sound of my call; have pity on me, and answer me. Of you my heart speaks; you my glance seeks. Res.

Your presence, O LORD, I seek. Hide not your face from me; do not in anger repel your servant. You are my helper: cast me not off. Res.

CATHOLIC FAITH TEACHING CORNER

Continuing from last week

1. PRAYER

Go deep in prayer this Lent; set aside more time to pray, a quiet place and a heart that is well-disposed to communicate with your Lord, God, and Savior.

On prayer, one suggestion that the Church constantly exhorts us to carry out is the meditation of the Word of God. Take the Readings for the day of the Mass and reflect on them daily. Ask Our Lady who meditated upon the word of God in her heart to help you in this most noble pursuit. Spend time in prayer and adoration and allow the Word of God to transform your heart and your life.

The first Sunday of Lent, the devil tempts Jesus to turn stones into bread and Jesus responds: "Man does not live on bread alone but on every word that comes forth from the mouth of God." Jesus expresses priorities here: first the Word of God and then the food for the stomach!

2. Confession

Lent is a time for conversion. The word in Greek is metanoia which means a change of heart and mind. As Catholics, the most efficacious means to attain true conversion of heart is through a direct encounter with Jesus the Healer. Jesus touches us and heals us in a special way in the Sacraments, but most especially in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Before going to Confession, why not read Luke 15, the Parables of God's mercy. I call it the "Lost and found chapter".

FAMILY	CON	NECTION	

In today's Gospel, the voice from heaven speaks to the disciples saying, "Listen to him." The Transfiguration was a focused moment for the disciples when they heard God speaking to them and experienced Jesus in glory. They most certainly left this focused moment with a new appreciation for the importance of Jesus' words even if they did not yet understand everything that he had taught them. During Lent, we are invited to consider our attentiveness to Jesus and to one another. In the pace and noise that often characterizes family life, how well do we listen to one another? What opportunities do we have for quiet prayer?

As you gather as a family, count the number of pieces of equipment in your home that produce sound: televisions, radios, CD players, computers, video games, etc. Observe if sometimes more than one piece of equipment is playing simultaneously and how this might affect communication. Discuss the question: What is it like to try to talk with one another when this equipment is on?

Read aloud today's Gospel, Luke 9:28-36. Consider whether the noise and peace of your family life allows family members opportunities for quiet prayer. During Lent, it may be appropriate for your family to choose a quiet time in the household by turning off televisions, radios, and CD players. Consider whether your family would like to establish such a time during this Season of Lent and suggest that it might allow you the opportunity to listen more attentively to one another and to find time for quiet prayer. Spend a few such moments as a family, asking God to help you listen well to one another and to Jesus.
