GUIDELINES

- 1. Corpus Christi Feast will be held in a form of a durbar.
- 2. The procession after Mass is to be solemn and devotional. No noise making.
- 3. No photographers or mobile phones will be allowed during the procession. Selfies should be avoided.
- 4. The procession is to begin from the Altar on the compound to the Reverend Sisters main gate, out to the church's entrance gate and end at the Altar.
- 5. Each group/society is to select 20 persons to join the procession. The procession should take 30 minutes.
- 6.Palanguin carriers are to be traditionally dressed; no shoes or trousers, traditional footwear and cloths only. Catholic Men Association members are to carry the palanguin.
- 7. Hymns will be sung during the procession.
- 8. The CTK Choir and the Angelic Choir will lead the priests during the procession.
- 9. Ushers are to ensure that members of the procession and the congregation conduct themselves appropriately.
- 10. All members of the congregation are entreated to be in traditional societal clothing or Parish cloth.
- 11. Those performing Liturgical functions on the day are to be dressed in their Liturgical attire.
- 12. A Priest will remain with those not taking part in the procession and will lead them through prayers.
- 13. The Marian Choir and St. Cecilia choir will remain with the seated congregation to assist the priest.
- 14. All group adoration performances will be limited to a maximum of 10 minutes per group. Group s are as follows;

1. Akan 2. Ga - Adangbe 3. Northern 4. Ewe 5. International 6. Youth

15. Those involved in the adoration must be in traditional clothing

16. Each group is to present a gift to the church.

6TH SUNDAY OF EASTER. YEAR C **COMMENTARY ON READINGS**

First Reading: Paul and Barnabas converted many Gentiles to the Christian faith. A dispute arose when some men insisted that non-Jews must first submit to the Mosaic Law and its traditions. Sitting in Council at Jerusalem, the Apostles firmly decided that the Church shall not impose Judaism on Gentile converts. (Acts 15:1-2,22-29)

May God have pity on us and bless us; may he let his face shine upon us. So may your way be known upon earth; among all nations, your salvation. Res.

May the nations be glad and exult because you rule the peoples in equity; the nations on the earth you guide. Res.

May the peoples praise you, O God; may all the peoples praise you! May God bless us, and may all the ends of the earth fear him. Res.

Second Reading: The visionary John describes the splendor of the Church, seeing the earthly and the heavenly Church in one perspective, recognizing the oneness of the people under Christ. The Church has a particular brilliance because it is lit by the radiant glory of the light of Christ.

MOTHER AND FATHER OF THE YEAR CORNER

The focus of the Mother and Father of year 2018/2019 has been on post-marriage counselling especially for young couples, and also on the spiritual and social development of the youth.

In line with this, marriage seminars have been organized for young couples while the youth have been encouraged to embark on a Social media fast on every first Sunday of the month from 6.00am to 6.00pm. What this means is that during the period, the youth take a decision to put away their phones, ipads and tablets, and shut themselves out of the social media, such as Facebook, Twitter, Whatsapp, Instagram etc, and use that time for reading scriptures and praying. Some young people have tried to make use of this period of 'abstinence' to spend time with the Lord and we believe our dear Lord will stay with them and lead them to a brighter future!

A career/job seminar has also been organized to create awareness among the youth of various career options available and how to enter into those careers including the priesthood as a vocation.

In our interaction, some of the youth have expressed the desire to learn and develop their entrepreneurial skills.

Some of the young couples who have attended the marriage seminars have also suggested that there is the need for couples who have been married for at least 10 Years to serve as mentors to younger couples.

We therefore wish to appeal for volunteers who can act as mentors to young couples or teachers or instructors in skills development.
