He rules by his might forever. **Res.**

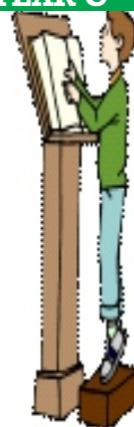
For God will save Zion

3. Will new technology provide immediate results?
