

COMMENTARY ON READINGS

First Reading: Abraham entertained three strangers, not knowing that he was entertaining God. Abraham's hospitality was rewarded, for his wife Sarah was promised a son the following year. (Genesis 18:1-10)

RESPONSORIAL PSALM (Ps. 15) "He who does justice will live in the presence of the Lord."

One who walks blamelessly and does justice; who thinks the truth in his heart and slanders not with his tongue. Res.

Who harms not his fellow man, nor takes up a reproach against his neighbour; by whom the reprobate is despised, while he honors those who fear the LORD. Res.

Who lends not his money at usury and accepts no bribe against the innocent. One who does these things shall never be disturbed. Res.

Second Reading: St. Paul tells his converts that the mystery of God's plan of salvation, kept hidden from all eternity, is now revealed in Jesus Christ.

(Colossians 1:24-28)

Gospel: When Jesus visits the two sisters, Martha gets busy with the hospitality while Mary sits listening to Jesus; and when Martha complains, Jesus insists that Mary's choice is the more essential for eternal salvation. (Luke 10:38-42)
