COMMENTARY ON READINGS

First Reading: This Reading speaks about the worthlessness of worldly acquisitions which, upon one's death, becomes someone else's property to misuse or to waste all that was painfully acquired. (Ecclesiastes 1:2. 2:21-23)

RESPONSORIAL PSALM (Ps. 90) " If today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts."

You turn man back to dust, saying, "Return, O children of men." For a thousand years in your sight are as yesterday, now that it is past, or as a watch of the night.. Res.

You make an end of them in their sleep; the next morning they are like the changing grass, Which at dawn springs up anew, but by evening wilts and fades. Res.
