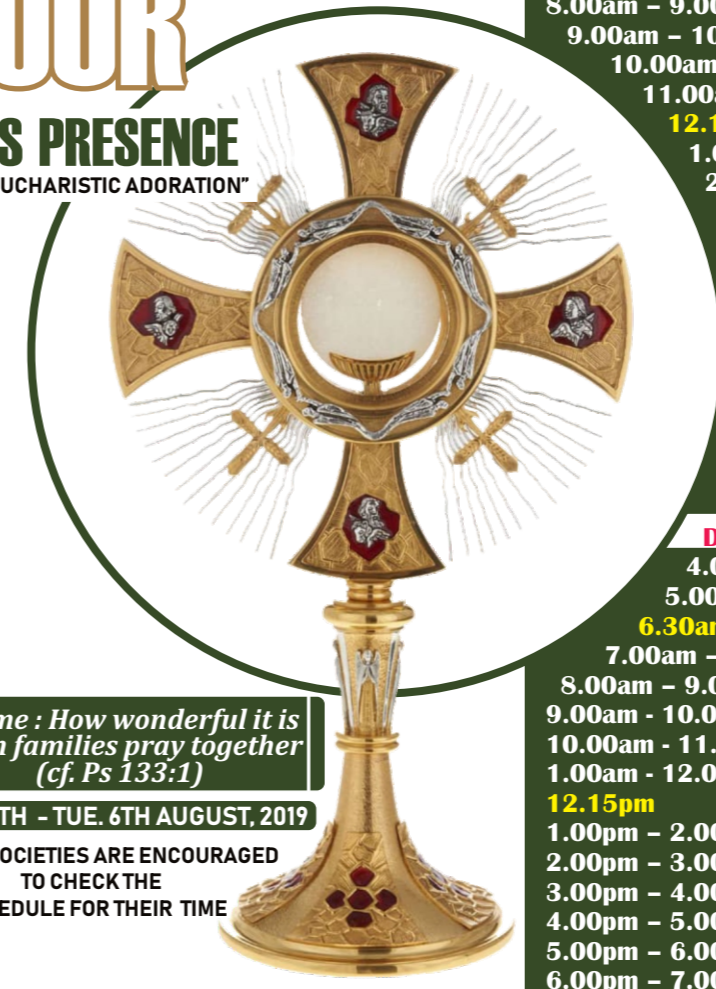

First Reading: This Reading speaks about the worthlessness of worldly acquisitions which, upon one's death, becomes someone else's property to misuse or to waste all that was painfully acquired. . (Ecclesiastes 1:2. 2:21-23)

“ If today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts.”

Teach us to number our days aright, that we may gain wisdom of heart. Return, O LORD! How long? Have pity on your servants! **Res.**

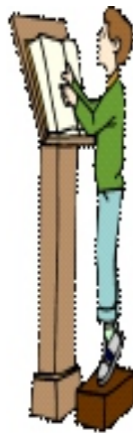
