COMMENTARY ON READINGS

First Reading: Jeremiah urged the rulers of Israel to be mindful of their covenant with God and to desist from evil. The rulers were hostile to his prophetic counsel, instead, they tried to kill Jeremiah by throwing him into a disused well. (Jeremiah 38:4-6, 8-10)


