COMMENTARY ON READINGS

First Reading: The sacred author underlines the importance of gentleness and humility, especially, for people in high positions. Such people find favor with God. (Sirach 3:17-20, 28-29)

RESPONSORIAL PSALM (Ps. 68)

"God, in your goodness, you have made a home for the poor."

The just rejoice and exult before God; they are glad and rejoice. Sing to God, chant praise to his name; whose name is the LORD. Res.

The father of orphans and the defender of widows is God in his holy dwelling. God gives a home to the forsaken; he leads forth prisoners to prosperity. Res.

A bountiful rain you showered down, O God, upon your inheritance;

you restored the land when it languished; your flock settled in it;

in your goodness, O God, you provided it for the needy

Second Reading: The manifestation of God on Mount Sinai to the people of Israel was a terrifying experience; by contrast, people of the New Covenant assemble on Mount Zion, without fear, to partake in the heavenly banquet that God grants, only to the humble. (Hebrews 12:18-19, 22-24)


