First Reading: Lacking knowledge and understanding, human beings have need for the gift of Wisdom that the Holy Spirit bestows on the humble who learn to please God and are saved. (Wisdom 9:13-18)

You turn man back to dust, saying, “Return, O children of men.” For a thousand years in your sight are as yesterday, now that it is past, or as a watch of the night. **Res.**

Teach us to number our days aright, that we may gain wisdom of heart. Return, O LORD! How long? Have pity on your servants! **Res.**

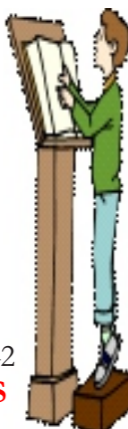
