COMMENTARY ON READINGS

First Reading: Amos, the prophet of social justice, preaches against the greedy merchants of his day. He condemns the exploitation of Israel's poor by the rich ruling classes and foretells God's just punishment against them. (Amos 8:4-7)

RESPONSORIAL PSALM (Ps. 51)

"I will rise and go to my father"

Have mercy on me, O God, in your goodness; in the greatness of your compassion wipe out my offense. Thoroughly wash me from my guilt and of my sin cleanse me.. Res.

A clean heart create for me, O God, and a steadfast spirit renew within me. Cast me not out from your presence, and your Holy Spirit take not from me Res.

O Lord, open my lips, and my mouth shall proclaim your praise. My sacrifice, O God, is a contrite spirit; a heart contrite and humbled, O God, you will not spurn.


