COMMENTARY ON READINGS

First Reading: The prophet questions why God allows injustice to triumph for so long. God's justice never delays; it surely comes in God's own good time. Consequently, just people must live by faith and wait patiently. (Habakkuk 1:2-3, 2:2-4)

RESPONSORIAL PSALM (Ps. 95)

“ If today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts.”

Come, let us sing joyfully to the LORD;
let us acclaim the Rock of our salvation.
Let us come into his presence with thanksgiving;
let us joyfully sing psalms to him.. **Res.**

Come, let us bow down in worship;
let us kneel before the LORD who made us.
For he is our God,
and we are the people he shepherds, the flock he guides. **Res.**

"Harden not your hearts as at Meribah,
as in the day of Massah in the desert,

Second Reading: Timothy is urged to fan into flame the gift that God gave him at his ordination as bishop. It was not a spirit of timidity but the love and power of the Holy Spirit to help Timothy to bear hardship for the sake of the Good News and to guard the deposit of faith entrusted to him. (Timothy 1:6-8, 13-14.)

Gospel: Faith and service to God do not entitle us to any reward. God does not owe us anything and when we have done our duty, we must consider ourselves useless servants who may only hope for God's mercy and graciousness. (Luke 17:5-10)

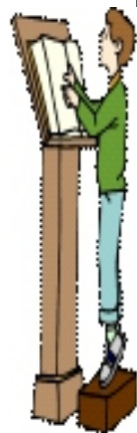
