

#### **COMMENTARY ON READINGS**

First Reading: When Naaman, the Syrian commander, realized that he was fully cured of leprosy, he converted to worship the true God of Israel and returned to the Prophet Elisha to give thanks to God. (Kings 5: 14-17)

#### RESPONSORIAL PSALM (Ps. 95)

" The Lord has revealed to the nations his saving power."
