COMMENTARY ON READINGS

First Reading: God's loving care reveals itself in the preservation of all things and in the forgiveness of sins. and speak of your might. **Res.**

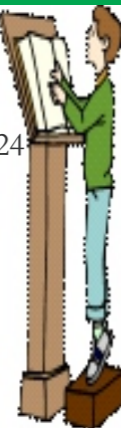
The LORD is faithful in all his words
