COMMENTARY ON READINGS

First Reading: We hear about the martyrdom of a mother and her seven sons who defied a pagan king and died rather than sin against God. They believed that if they remained faithful to the end, God would grant them everlasting life. (Maccabees 7:1-2, 9-14)

RESPONSORIAL PSALM (Ps. 17)

"Lord, when your glory appears, my joy will be full."

Hear, O LORD, a just suit; attend to my outcry;

hearken to my prayer from lips without deceit. Res.

My steps have been steadfast in your paths, my feet have not faltered. I call upon you, for you will answer me, O God;

incline your ear to me; hear my word. Res.

Keep me as the apple of your eye, hide me in the shadow of your wings. But I in justice shall behold your face; on waking I shall be content in your presence. Res.

Second Reading: Paul prays for his converts and pleads with them to pray, not only, for the success of his missionary work, but also, for the preservation of the Church from interference by fanatic and evil men.. (Thessalonians 2:16-3:5)

Gospel: The Sadducees challenge Jesus, intending to ridicule His teaching concerning the resurrection of the dead and life everlasting. Jesus uses their insincere enquiry as an opportunity to deliver clear, authentic teaching on marriage. (Luke 20:27-38)
