#### **COMMENTARY ON READINGS**

First Reading: When Judgment Day comes, God's justice will finally be seen by all in the utter destruction of the wicked and the triumph of good people who revere the name of the Lord. (Malachi 3:19-20)

RESPONSORIAL PSALM (Ps. 98) "The Lord comes to rule the earth with justice."

Sing praise to the LORD with the harp, with the harp and melodious song. With trumpets and the sound of the horn sing joyfully before the King, the LORD. Res.

Let the sea and what fills it resound, the world and those who dwell in it; let the rivers clap their hands, the mountains shout with them for joy. Res.

Before the LORD, for he comes, for he comes to rule the earth, he will rule the world with justice and the peoples with equity. Res.

Second Reading: Some Christians of the early Church saw no need to work because they expected that the Second Coming of Christ was about to happen soon. Paul urged them to work for their living but not to live at the expense of the community. (Thessalonians 3:7-12)
