

# **EPIPHANY SUNDAY, YEAR A**COMMENTARY ON READINGS

**First Reading:** This reading recounts three prophecies: the revelation of the glory of the Messiah; the coming of Jesus Christ from among God's chosen people, and, the Three Wise Men who sought, found and adored the Lord Jesus, the Light of the world. **(Isaiah 60:1-6)** 

### RESPONSORIAL PSALM (Ps. 72) "Lord, every nation on earth will adore you."

O God, with your judgment endow the king, and with your justice, the king's son; He shall govern your people with justice and your afflicted ones with judgment. **Res.** 

Justice shall flower in his days, and profound peace, till the moon be no more. May he rule from sea to sea, and from the River to the ends of the earth. **Res.** 

The kings of Tarshish and the Isles shall offer gifts; the kings of Arabia and Seba shall bring tribute. All kings shall pay him homage, all nations shall serve him. **Res.** 

For he shall rescue the poor when he cries out, and the afflicted when he has no one to help him. He shall have pity for the lowly and the poor; the lives of the poor he shall save. **Res.** 

**Second Reading:** St. Paul teaches that God invites both Jews and Gentiles to share in the salvation brought by Christ. Accordingly, God's plan of salvation is meant for all people and it must be preached to all without exception.

(Ephesians 3:2-3, 5-6)

**Gospel:** Three Wise Men came to Jerusalem seeking the newborn King of the Jews. With hope, they followed a star that led them to the Child Jesus, the Infant King, to whom they paid homage and offered a treasury of precious gifts.

(Matthew 2:1-12)


