## **HOLY FAMILY SUNDAY, YEAR A COMMENTARY ON READINGS**

First Reading: This passage is a commentary on the fourth commandment which reminds grown up children about their responsibilities towards their aged parents. (Sirach 3:2-6, 12-14)

#### **RESPONSORIAL PSALM (Ps. 24)**

"Blessed are those who fear the Lord and walk in his ways."

Blessed is everyone who fears the LORD, who walks in his ways! For you shall eat the fruit of your handiwork; blessed shall you be, and favored. Res.

Your wife shall be like a fruitful vine in the recesses of your home; your children like olive plants around your table. Res.

Behold, thus is the man blessed who fears the LORD. The LORD bless you from Zion: may you see the prosperity of Jerusalem all the days of your life. Res.

Second Reading: St. Paul dwells on the atmosphere of mutual concern and love that should prevail in Christian families and communities. His teaching places special emphasis on forgiveness for one another.

(Colossians 3:12-21)

Gospel: After the Wise Men had left without reporting back to Herod who had planned to kill the Child Jesus, God commanded Joseph to take the Child and Mary His mother to safety in Egypt where they remained until Herod died.. (Matthew 2:13-15, 19-23)


