COMMENTARY ON READINGS

First Reading: The prophet tells the people of Israel that true worship of God consists in the practice of justice and genuine concern for the poor and the needy.

(Malachi 3:1-4)

RESPONSORIAL PSALM (Ps. 24) "Who is this king of glory? It is the Lord!."

Light shines through the darkness for the upright; he is gracious and merciful and just. Well for the man who is gracious and lends, who conducts his affairs with justice. Res.
