First Reading: We are called upon to avoid enmity, revenge and grudge against our neighbour. As God is holy, so also should we endeavour by his grace to be holy.

(Leviticus 19:1-2, 17-18)

RESPONSORIAL PSALM (Ps. 103) "The Lord is kind and merciful."

Bless the LORD, O my soul; and all my being, bless His holy name. Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits. Res.

He pardons all your iniquities, heals all your ills. He redeems your life from destruction, crowns you with kindness and compassion Res.


