**ALMSGIVING**

This is the most important practice of Lent. To give alms is in a concrete way to express Love. Love, the greatest of the theological virtues means "to will the good of the other". To help the poor, that is, any one in need. We must ask ourselves this question, what am I doing to help the poor? What service can I offer to any one in need?

Below are some recommendations

1. Tithe - You can decide to give 10 percent of your income to help anyone in need.
2. Always have loose change on you to give to those who are struggling to make ends meet.
3. You can decide to give to anyone who asks you in this season of lent
4. Do not ask for reduction in price when you go to the market to buy.
5. Get a box and drop some money in it when leaving the house. At the end of the Lenten season, you can donate the money to an orphanage.
6. Pick one of the Corporal and Spiritual works of Mercy and make it your own this season of lent.

To conclude, the theological significance of lent is to seek the face of God and these pillars helps us, as we journey through these 40 days of Lent. it will be sad if we pass through the lent rather than letting the lent pass through us. The Lenten season must change us and we must see the face of God. Do something this Lenten Season. God bless us all.

**First Reading:** God's true servant suffers in carrying out his mission. He undergoes much humiliation for the Lord's sake but he is convinced that God will eventually justify him. **(Isaiah 50:4-7)**

## GUIDELINES FOR BURIAL MASS AND WEDDINGS IN CHRIST THE KING CHURCH

### FUNERALS

- No flowers, wreaths to be brought into the Church.
- Seating arrangements – 2/1 in benches.
- 150 allowed into Church for service.
- Doors closed when Church is full.
- Death certificate to be authenticated by medical authority.
- Food packs to be given out at main entrances on leaving the church.
- No filing past the body or opening of coffin.
- Coffin to be cordoned off.
- Family to submit list of invitees to office staff.
- No cloth to be draped over coffin during service.

### WEDDINGS

- Group photographs to be taken in Church after wedding ceremony.
- All wear masks – Bride and Groom exempted.
- Food packs to be distributed on exiting the church/chapel after wedding.
- No cutting of cake ceremony or reception after wedding.

when it is proclaimed in its entirety. Families can make it a tradition to read a portion of this Sunday's Gospel each day of the Holy Week, providing ample opportunity for children to ask questions and respond to the events described there. In this way, the entire week can become a “way of the cross.”

Each day during Holy Week, the family can gather in a prayerful space with a crucifix as its focal point. The passion as found in Mark's Gospel might be read as follows throughout the week:

Sunday:Mark 11:1-10 (Gospel at the Procession with Palms)

Monday:Mark 14:1-11

Tuesday:Mark 14:12-26

Wednesday:Mark 14:27-52

Thursday:Mark 14:53-72

Friday:Mark 15:1-41

Saturday:Mark 15:42-47

After reading from the Gospel each night, the family might reflect on the reading together. Conclude your prayer time together by praying the Lord's Prayer or by singing an appropriate hymn such as “Jesus, Jesus,” “Were You There When They Crucified My Lord?” or “What Wondrous Love is This.”
