SOLEMNITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, YEAR B

First Reading: The Old Covenant that God entered into with His people on Mount Sinai, was sealed with sacrificial animals' blood which Moses sprinkled over the people of Israel in order to restore the holiness of their outward lives..(Exodus 24:3-8)

RESPONSORIAL PSALM (Ps. 116)

“I will take the cup of salvation, and call on the name of the Lord.”

How shall I make a return to the LORD for all the good he has done for me? The cup of salvation I will take up, and I will call upon the name of the LORD. **Res**

THE FAMILY CONNECTION

In the beginning of today's Gospel, Jesus instructs his disciples to make preparations for the Passover meal. Like most meals, the Passover meal required planning and preparation. Our celebration of the Sunday Eucharist also requires planning and preparation. Certainly the ministers of the Eucharist prepare for their roles: the person presiding prays and prepares the homily; the prayers of petition are written; the music ministers prayerfully select music and practice it before Mass; Eucharistic ministers, lectors and knights of the altar prepare carefully for their roles. As the worshiping assembly, we can also prepare for Mass through prayer during the week, by reading the Scripture before Mass, and by making ourselves present for the Eucharistic celebration.

As you gather as a family, talk about some of the things that are required to prepare for your family meals. Plan together a special Sunday meal by choosing the menu, preparing the shopping list, and assigning duties for cooking, setting the table, preparing decorations, leading the prayers, and cleaning. Read together today's Gospel, Mark 14:12-16,22-26. Notice how Jesus instructed his disciples to prepare for their Passover meal. All meals require some kind of planning and preparation; so, too, our Sunday Eucharist requires planning. What might we do as a family to better prepare for our celebration of the Eucharist? Choose one or more ideas to begin to implement together as a family. Pray together that God will help your family make your celebration of the Eucharist the highlight of your week. Pray together the Lord's Prayer.

AMENDED GUIDELINES FOR BURIAL MASS AND WEDDINGS IN CHRIST THE KING CHURCH

FUNERALS

1. Requiem Mass will be strictly one and half hour duration.
2. Total duration of tributes read in church should not exceed 20 minutes (total number of tributes read to be discussed with officiating priest).
3. Seating will be 3:2
4. Maximum seats in chapel 300. Option of hiring Parish hall for live streaming if additional capacity desired.
5. Main Chapel doors will be cordoned off when the seating capacity of 300 is reached.
6. Death Certificate to be authenticated by medical authority
7. Food packs to be distributed on exiting the chapel/hall after requiem Mass.
8. Filing past should be done under supervision of ushers maintaining strict social distancing.
9. Coffin together with any wreaths to be cordoned off.
10. Family to submit list of invitees to office staff.

WEDDINGS

1. Group photographs with officiating priests to be taken in church after wedding ceremony.
2. Group photographs with family and friends to be taken outdoors after wedding ceremony.
3. Mandatory wearing of face masks on church premises by all except the bride and groom.
4. Food packs to be distributed on exiting the chapel/hall after wedding.
