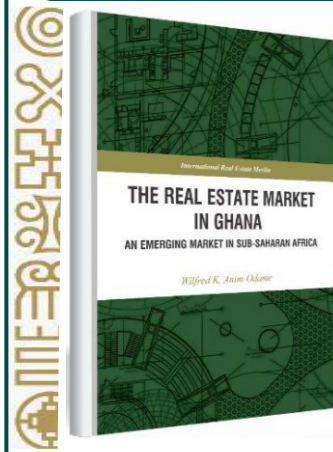

- ✦ Complete the registration forms
- ✦ Get all your documents ready.
- ✦ Some documentation required:
- ✦ Passport (valid for at least 6 months after the Pilgrimage)
- ✦ Recommendation letter from your parish priest
- ✦ Introductory letter from your school/business/institution.
- ✦ Bank statements of participant and sponsor: 3-6 months
- ✦ Completed Schengen Visa Application Form
- ✦ Business papers such as a business registration certificate, tax clearance certificates, proof of an active business (bills of lading, import declaration forms, invoices (if self-employed).
- ✦ Salary slips for the last three months or an employment contract (if employed)
- ✦ Other documents such as birth certificate, marriage certificate, baptism card, recent passport pictures, yellow card etc.

THE FAMILY CONNECTION

When a child is baptized, the parents speak on behalf of the child in professing the faith in which the child is to be baptized. The parents promise to teach their child this faith so that they may one day accept this faith as his or her own. In the example of Simon Peter, we learn that each person must also make his or her own profession of faith in Jesus as the one sent by God to save us. We pray for our children as they mature in the faith that they may learn that Jesus alone has the words of eternal life and that they may choose to follow the way of Christian discipleship.

As you gather as a family, talk about promise that parents make at their child's baptism to teach their child about Jesus and the faith of the Church. Talk about the importance of this promise to your family and about some of the things that you are doing to try to honor this commitment. In today's Gospel we hear Simon Peter speak about what he has come to believe about Jesus. Together read today's Gospel, John 6:60-69. Pray together that each person in our family will grow in his or her faith that Jesus is the one sent by God who alone has the words of eternal life.

Pray together the Apostles' Creed or the Nicene Creed.
