



THE PASTOR'S DESK

The precepts of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart.

Our Holy Father, Pope Francis, on the 30th of September 2019, directed that the third Sunday of Ordinary Time should be "devoted to the celebration, study, and dissemination of the word of God." ("Aperuit Illis" Instituting The Sunday Of The Word Of God) According to Pope Francis, "The relationship between the Risen Lord, the community of believers and sacred Scripture is essential to our identity as Christians. Without the Lord who opens our minds to them, it is impossible to understand the Scriptures in depth. Yet the contrary is equally true: without the Scriptures, the events of the mission of Jesus and of his Church in this world would remain incomprehensible."

The scriptures for today focus our attention on the importance and power of the Word of God. The first reading is from the book of the prophet Nehemiah. A little bit of context would help us appreciate the depth of the reading. After defeating Babylon, King Cyrus of Persia directed that the exiled Jews return home to Jerusalem. The Jews who returned rebuilt their ruined Temple and the city walls. The Lord instructed Ezra and Nehemiah, their leaders, to also teach the Hebrew Scriptures and inspire the people to appreciate the tenets of worship.

In today's reading, Ezra leads the people in a Covenant renewal ceremony. As part of the ceremony, Ezra read the book of the Law from daybreak till midday, in the presence of the men, the women, and those children old enough to understand. How the community received the word of God is worth noting. We are told: the people listened attentively to the book of the law. Do we listen attentively to the Word of God when it is proclaimed in our assembly? The people's reaction is also noteworthy: all the people were weeping as they heard the words of the law. Their response meant that the words of the law made a deep impression on their hearts and, therefore, evoked an immediate response. Paul tells us That the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart (Hebrews 4:12). Each time we read or hear the Word of God, not only are we to listen attentively but also we need to respond to God's word in ways that enhance our spirituality.

The responsorial Psalm from Psalm 119 also reflects on the beauty of God's Word: The law of the LORD is perfect, refreshing the soul; the decree of the LORD is trustworthy, giving wisdom to the simple. The precepts of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart; the ordinances of the LORD are true, all of them just. The command of the LORD is clear, enlightening the eye. In this excerpt, the Psalmist highlights the three qualities of God's words; namely, it is the source of wisdom, the fountain of joy, and the source of true vision.

I pray that we will always make time for the word of God. May the joy of the Lord be your strength.
